Founders' Day

Grace Church was founded on September 27, 1855 by parishioners from Christ Church and St. Paul's to respond to the growing population of Alexandria. For the first two years the congregation worshipped at the Lyceum on South Washington Street. By 1857, the undercroft (basement) of the new Church on South Patrick Street could be used for services. The nave and High Altar were consecrated in 1860. In 1947, the parish decided to sell the Patrick Street property and build a new church on Russell Road. The "new" church was dedicated on December 5, 1948. The parish school building, now named Merrow Hall, opened in 1959. Extensive renovations and additions were completed in 1995. On the last Sunday in September we observe this anniversary with either the proper for St. Michael and All Angels or those for the dedication of a church.

Stewardship Reflection

In the Holy Eucharist, our simple gifts of bread and wine are returned to us as Christ's own eternal self-offering. What if we invited the same Spirit that consecrates such holy food and drink to transform our whole selves? The more we share of our gifts in Christian community, the more we grow into that abundant life our Lord promises.
