The continuo organ is Phase One of a new organ project for Grace Church. The builder is Di Gennaro-Hart Organ Builders of McLean, Virginia (Michael Hart, *Managing Director*). The case and engineering layout was designed by Michael Hart and construction was by Patrick Quigley. Tonal design and voicing was by Lawrence Trupiano. In the coming year, the choir gallery of Grace Church will be enlarged so that the Di Gennaro-Hart Company can install a new three-manual instrument (scheduled for completion by Easter of 2009). Once that organ is installed, the continuo will continue to be playable as a stand-alone instrument, but it will also be playable from the main console as an antiphonal division.
