#### **Interim Assistant to the Rector**

The Rev. David Crosby will join the staff effective January 1, 2019 to serve as a part-time Assistant to the Rector. He will work at Grace 10-12 hours each week and primarily participate in liturgical leadership and pastoral care as time allows. David was a very active lay leader at Grace for many years while employed in the corporate world. In 2009, Grace sponsored David as a postulant for Holy Orders in the Diocese and he started at V.T.S. that Fall.
